## TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

Free COVID-19 Vaccination Camp at Sammilani Mahavidyalaya was organised jointly by the IQAC and the NSS unit of the institution with collaboration with the Department of Health and Family welfare, Government of West Bengal and Department of Higher Education, State Government. The camp was organised for two days, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Both Covishield and Covaxine were given to students, teachers and non-teaching staff above 18 years of age. As per the NTAGI (National Technical Advisory Group on Immunisation) Covishield (41221P219) has to be administered at an interval of 84 days and Covaxine (37121019) second dose can be given after a month of one month.

In this Vaccination Drive at Sammilani Mahavidyalaya, a total number of 145 males and 98 females were vaccinated during a time span of two days. The breakup of vaccines is given in the table below.





## Code of Conduct and Professional Ethics

### FOR STUDENTS

**[There are several rules and regulations mentioned in the college prospectus that has to be followed by the students along with the following code of conduct]**

- i) Students must be regular and punctual in attending scheduled classes and have to secure stipulated percentage of attendance as directed by the University of Calcutta. Absence in classes, test/examinations, non-submission of projects/assignments without producing proper document will be treated as violation of rules.
- ii) Students must wear and display their identity cards at the entry point and always keep wearing the same during college hours.
- iii) Students must follow the notices in the notice board (offline/online). If ignored, college authority will not be responsible.
- iv) Use of mobile phone during classes without permission of the teacher is strictly prohibited.



## ENERGY CONSERVATION INITIATIVE

The institution installed a solar power generating unit at the roof top of the college building on 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2016, which was sponsored by the Ministry of power, Government of West Bengal. This solar power generating unit, having a capacity of 20 KW and comprising 80 solar panels, generates 35 to 40 units of electricity per day. This has reduced the consumption of electricity by the institution to a considerable extent.

The institution has a sensor-based switch for energy conservation at the eastern entrance gate. CESC Ltd. Installed a smart-meter in the college premises for monitoring and managing electricity consumption. Besides, all the normal tube lights and incandescent bulbs have been replaced by LED lights, as an energy conservation measure.


