
Students' Feedback on Curriculum 2020-21


The courses / syllabi have a good balance between theory and application: 876 responses

The objectives of the syllabi are well defined: 876 responses








- ➤ According to 64.8% students, the recommended books, journals, and other reference materials are pertinent, up-to-date, and encompass the entirety of the syllabi.

- ➤ 13.9% students reported that the prescribed books, journals, and reference materials are not pertinent and up-to-date, providing comprehensive coverage of the entire syllabi sometimes.

The courses / syllabi of the subjects taught increased interest, knowledge and perspective in the subject area:



- ➤ 16.1% students reported that the college's curriculum enhances the employability of its students sometimes.


