8. Value based cultural and social initiatives


## Term of MoU:

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to develop academic and educational cooperation, to promote mutual understanding between the two institutions in a bid to enhance quality of education and facilitate teaching learning process. This MoU is presented by Dr. Santiranjana Palchoudhuri, Principal, Sammilani Mahavidyalaya and Dr. Ramkrishna Prasad Chakraborty, Principal, K.K. Das College to identify priorities for bilateral cooperation in the field of education, as envisaged by UGC and NAAC.

### Principles and Objective:

This MoU intends to frame the general principles of mutual cooperation and common interest to carry out cooperative activities on the basis of reciprocity and mutual benefit in the field of education.

This MoU is not intended to create any legally binding rights or obligations and will be carried out within the framework of Indian Laws and Regulations.

### Scope of Cooperation to be encouraged:

Each institution agrees to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic:

1. Exchange of academic information, materials, scholarly articles and publications.
2. Exchange of students and faculties.
3. Conducting collaborative research projects.
4. Conducting lectures and organizing symposia.
5. Promoting collaboration in fields of mutual interest.
6. Promoting other academic cooperation as mutually agreed.
7. Quality and value based initiatives in cultural and social activities.

## Implementation and Funding:

The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MoU will be separately negotiated and agreed between the two colleges.

The two institutions will establish a joint committee for policy dialogue to regularly exchange information and experience on education challenges and reforms.

The cost of cooperative activities may be funded as mutually determined and all the cooperative activities under this MoU will be subject to the availability of fund.

## Terms of MoU:

This MoU is valid for a period of five years from the date of signing by the authorized signatories of each institution. Each institution shall review the status of the MoU at least three months before the end of the five-year period to determine whether it wishes the MoU to continue and, if so, any modifications that might be necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may only be extended by the mutual written consent of both institutions.

## Other Conditions:

Both institutions agree that prior written approval is required before using the other institution's name, logo, or other Intellectual Property rights in any advertising or associated publicity.

This MoU may only be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of each institution.

This MoU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the institutions upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than six months before the termination date.

The Academic Linkage under this MoU shall uphold the ethos of holistic and integrated academic excellence and growth followed by all higher education institutions of the country. It shall not in any way impede or affect the individuality and distinctiveness of each other.

## WHEREAS

- A. **The Institution** is an undergraduate college affiliated to the University of Calcutta in Kolkata, West Bengal.
- B. **Vital Waste** is engaged in providing Recycling and Waste Management services for dry recyclables such as Paper, Cardboard, Plastic, Metal and E-waste in India.
- C. **Vital Waste** approached **The Institution** to provide recycling and allied waste management services for its premises in Kolkata and **The Institution** agreed to appoint **Vital Waste** for providing the aforementioned services on the following terms and conditions as set herein.

**NOW THE PARTIES MENTIONED HEREIN HAVE WITNESSETH AND HEREBY DECLARE, UNDERTAKE AND AGREE AS UNDER:**

### ARTICLE-1 DEFINITIONS

Unless otherwise clearly required by the context, the following terms shall have the respective meanings as defined below:

- (a) "**Collection Staff**" shall mean employees/staff of **Vital Waste** responsible for packaging and collection of Recyclables.
- (b) "**Main Storage Location**" shall mean storage location where all the Dry Recyclables will be stored for collection and this location should be accessible to collection vehicle of **Vital Waste**.
- (c) "**Recyclables**" means any type of dry waste (Non Hazardous) which is not contaminated and can be reused or recycled into a new product.
- (d) "**Recycle Points**" means points awarded by **Vital Waste** for per kg of Recyclables. **1 Recycle Point = 1.00 INR.**
- (e) "**Collection Site**" shall be at premises of Sammilani Mahavidyalaya, E.M. Bypass, Baghajatin Kolkata- 700094.

## ARTICLE-2

### APPOINTMENT OF VITAL WASTE

- 2.1 **The Institution** hereby appointed Vital Waste to provide the recycling and allied waste management services for its **Collection Site**.
- 2.2 **Vital Waste** will collect the dry recyclables from the premises of **The Institution** as per the terms and conditions mentioned in this MOU.
- 2.3 **Vital Waste** will look after the matter of taking away chemical waste from laboratories.
- 2.4 **The Institution** will provide waste and will get E-certificate for recycling the waste.

## ARTICLE-3

### RECYCLING PROGRAMME

- 3.1 **The Institution** will collect the entire waste in main storage location within the premises.
- 3.2 After collection of minimum quantity of 200 kg waste, the representative of **The Institution** shall intimate to **Vital Waste** to collect waste and to initiate the recycling Program.
- 3.3 **Vital Waste** will provide collection activity.
- 3.5 Collection Staff of **Vital Waste** will collect the Recyclables from the premises of **The Institution** after getting the collection requirement from the office of **The Institution** on next the day or within 3 working days from the receipt of collection request from the office of **The Institution**.
- 3.6 Collections are performed on working days, i.e. Monday to Saturday of every week, between 10.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. except public holidays.
- 3.7 If the office of **The Institution** is located in high rise building in such case the housekeeping staff of **The Institution** will bring the Recyclables to the location accessible to Collection Staff of **Vital Waste** or assist the Collection Staff of **Vital Waste** for collections of Recyclables.
- 3.8 Collection Staff of **Vital Waste** will be equipped with the weighing machines to perform the measurement of Recyclables in the presence of representative of **The Institution**.

This Agreement is a non-exclusive agreement, and both parties remain free to enter into similar agreements with third parties.

#### **VI. SPECIAL PROVISIONS**


1. Each party will take approval from the other party in writing prior to using the name and logo for the activities hereunder on a case-by-case basis.
