Gender Audit Report 2021-22

Preface

Sammilani Mahavidyalaya is a co-educational general degree college catering to the students of South 24 Parganas and South Kolkata. A considerable percentage of its students are girls and hail from families of farmers, land laborers and have poor financial background. Under-age marriage, female child malnutrition, girl trafficking, dowry, domestic violence targeting women, etc. are prevalent in this region. The Women Cell and Equal Opportunity & Gender Equity Cell at Sammilani Mahavidyalaya believe providing them with only higher education is not enough to eradicate or ease those age-old problems; their higher education should be supplemented with appropriate initiatives on women empowerment. To equip them potentially to fight the menace the Cells believe that understanding of the gender reality is the first and foremost pre-requisite.

Context

Sex is determined by birth but gender is a social construction from which all sorts of inequalities emerge. Social gender equality cannot be achieved and sustained as long as even a small fraction of society remains marginalized and thus kept behind. However, identifying our own limitations in defining different gender identities and acts accordingly goes above any sort of gendered norms that is harmful or even hurting any member of the society. Youths have the power which has undeniable influence in constructing and deconstructing existing social values which will ultimately change the way of social living across gender including all - male, female, transgender, gender neutral, non-binary, pangender, genderqueer, two-spirit, third gender, and all, none or a combination of these.

Therefore, the Women Cell and Equal Opportunity & Gender Equity Cell at Sammilani Mahavidyalaya tried to initiate a social survey, called gender audit, among our own students regarding their views on some selected personal, family and social issues. The survey tried to capture the gendered familial educational profile and earning status of each respondent as their background as well.

Objective

The main objective of gender audit is women empowerment through generation of awareness by providing them with knowledge on prevailing perception on various gender related issues as listed below:

- Brief structure related to existing social norms
- Purpose of pursuing education
- Existence of gender inequality in family, in the institution and in their society, if any



- The causes behind sexual harassment, if any
- The position of all members irrespective of all genders in their family about equal opportunity in education, in equal access of food & nutrition, medical treatment, equal participation in decision making, equal freedom in choosing dresses
- Whether the college campus is safe for all specially for women and transgender
- Opinion on women rights
- Facilities like self-defense training programs, sports facility, grievance redressal cell, Women's cell, Internal Complaints Committee

Methodology

The Women Cell and Equal Opportunity & Gender Equity Cell conducted the gender audit through Google Form in order to collate the respondents' perception on the existing belief structure of the respondents on different social norms like gender role in work, both inside and outside household, reservation facilities in public transportation, son preference in the family, societal norms, etc. Since the status of women at home and in the society at large depends on the mindset of all the stakeholders, in addition to other prevailing customs and practices, it has collected data from the girl and boy students as well and on various issues ranging from their personal opinion, family practice to societal norms.

A set of questionnaires (Annexure 1) have been asked to the present and recent pass-out students (as due to COVID-19 pandemic normal activities of them were hindered during lockdown) through Google form. Both MCQ type and short answer type questionnaires have been floated. Data and diagrams were collected as produced on the Google Analysis Form.

Analysis of the Survey (Session 2021-2022):

1. Family Profile of the Respondents

a. Sex Composition:




Figure 1: Over all Sex Composition of Student's Family (Session 2021-2022)

The analysis shows that the number of males in the families of all 86 respondents for the session 2021–2022 is 166 (49.85%) while the total number of females is 167 (50.15%) (Figure 1). The overall sex ratio is approximately 1006 females per 1000 male.

a. Educational Attainment of the respondents' family:

The illiteracy level for respondents' fathers is 1.16% and that of mothers is 5.81%. The percentage of educational attainment of respondents' fathers up to Under Graduate (U.G.) level is higher than that of mothers except at secondary level. However, at PG level the educational attainment for both the parents is same (3.49%) (Table 1).

It can therefore be concluded that the students of this college come from a family background where 31.40% fathers and 12.79% of mothers are educated at undergraduate level and at postgraduate level the percentage of educational attainment for the parents is the same (3.49%). But 1.16% of fathers and 5.81% of mothers are still illiterate. Interestingly, the next generation shows the brighter picture such as the disappearance of illiteracy and higher education among female members of the family. It is evident from **Table - 1** that the percentage of sisters attaining UG and PG level is significantly higher than that of brothers of the students. This is due to the number of older sisters being more in number than that of the elder brothers of the students.

a. Earning Status of the Family:




Figure 2: Earning Status of the family of the respondents (Session 2021-2022)

It is evident from Figure 2 that male earning members of the family of the respondents' is 79% and women earning members is 21%.

Therefore, the majority of the bread winners are male.

a. Student's Opinion about his/her family's Gender Power Structure in Basic Access and Decision-Making:




Figure 3: Student's Opinion about his/her family's Gender Power Structure in Basic Access and Decision-Making (Session 2021-2022)

Figure 3 analyses the gender power structure in accessing a few basic opportunities and participation of all genders in family decision making.

In accessing the equal opportunities in education, food and nutrition, medical treatment, equal freedom in choosing dress, it is observed that highest level of gender equality is attained in medical treatment (96% of respondents) followed by food and nutrition (91%), education (89%), equal participation in decision making for family matters (86%). 80% of the students responded for equal freedom in choosing dress.

1. Inspiration and purpose of pursuing college education by the respondents:

38% of the students responded that the main inspiration behind their college education comes from father and 27% of the students responded that the inspiration comes from mother and followed by elder sisters. Therefore, it is concluded that the main inspiration and support behind college education comes from the family.




Figure 4: Inspiration behind college education of the students (Session 2021-2022)

Purpose of College education:




Figure 5: Purpose of college education (Session 2021-2022)

Majority (52%) of the students consider employment and self grooming as the most important purpose behind college education and 33% of the students consider acquiring knowledge. Whereas, 10% of the students think financial empowerment is the purpose



behind their college education. However, few students respond for good marriage, social status, to avail kanyashree scheme and to get stipend as their main purpose of their college education (Figure 5).

2. Students' opinion on Social Problems according to importance of incidence:




Figure 6a: Students' opinion on Social Problems (Session 2021-2022)

Rape, Terrorism, Violence against woman, Unemployment, Dowry, Feticide, Communalism, Human trafficking and Corruption are most common current problems in today's society. According to the students the most important problem in our society is diagnosed as unemployment (42%) it is followed by corruption (30%), Rape of Woman (16%), Human trafficking (6%), Violence against woman (3%), Communalism (1%), Terrorism (1%), Dowry (1%) (Figure 6a).




Figure 6b: Incidents occurred in the students' family (Session 2021-2022)

13% of the students reported that such type of incident occurred in their family (Figure 6b)





About under-age marriage 5% of the students agreed such type of incidents occurred in their family (Figure 6e)





Belief Structure of Students on Social Norms




Figure 7: Belief structure of students on social norms (Session 2021-2022)

The survey result shows that 53% of the young respondents disagree with Violence on men and dominate over that of women. As far as the effectiveness of the kanyashree scheme in promoting college education to women to boost up their empowerment 19% of the students doubt the effectiveness of the scheme. Regarding the seat reservation for women in public transport nearly 64% of the respondents agree with the preference. The cause behind the preference lies in practical harassment experienced by the women while travelling in public transport. The role of male and female inside and outside of the family show a very positive direction for the society. 82% of the students disagree with the statement "Female inside household and men in outside workplace". The survey result shows that almost 90% agree with the statement "Women should be in decision / policy making roles wherever possible" (Figure 7).

3. Reason behind Violence/ Sexual Harassment against women and Transgender:




Figure 8: Reason behind violence/sexual harassment against women and transgender:

According to analysis it is observed that 42% of the respondents consider the most important cause behind the Violence/ Sexual Harassment against women and Transgender is Lack of awareness on the existing law. It is followed by Family indifference and Internet based Social media effect (13%), Police inaction and Unemployment problem (7% both), Male Lust and improper dress (5%), Incautiousness and effect of TV and serials (3% both) (Figure 8).

4. Opinion of students about the existence gender sensitivity in the institution:




Figure 9: Opinion of students about the existence of gender sensitivity in the institution

58% of the students believe that there is no gender sensitivity exists in the institution (Figure 9).

5. Awareness of the existing facilities of the institution:




Figure 10: Awareness of the existing facilities of the institution

Most of the students (77%) are aware of the existence of the sports facilities provided by the institution. 73% of the students were aware that the institution conducted a self defense program. 63% of the students are aware about the existence of the internal complaints cell to prevent sexual harassment in the institution. However, 61% of the students are aware about the Grievance redressal cell. 79% of the students are aware that the institution has not yet installed a sanitary pad vending machine (Figure 10).

More than two-third respondents believe equality is prevalent in medical treatment, education, food and nutrition, and decision making. However, there is a lower extent of liberty in choosing a dress to wear.

More than 52% of them believe main objective of education is to get settled in life through employment and for future wellbeing. However, they are concerned with unemployment and corruption.

In total about one-third respondents are concerned about rape, human trafficking, violence and dowry. Interestingly, percentage households offering dowry and receiving family are the same.

Seat reservation in public transport is a must for safety of the girls – about 64% demand the same to avoid bullying and sexual harassment during public transport. They also believe that lack of awareness on existing laws to prevent sexual harassment is the main reason for the menace in the society.

A sign of women empowerment is visible from the survey analysis – 82% of the respondents disagree with the slogan 'female inside, male outside'. And 90% respondent believe women should be in decision making also.

More than 70% respondents acknowledge the role of the institution in providing sports facilities, self-defence courses for girls, Internal Complaints Committee, Anti-ragging Cell and Grievance Cell. However, they feel a sanitary pad vending machine will ease some issues related to privacy and hygiene

Recommendation of the audit team:


- 1) To organize more sensitization programme like seminars, workshops, etc. on women empowerment

Gender Audit Report 2022-23

Introduction

Sammilani Mahavidyalaya is a co-educational general degree college affiliated to the University of Calcutta. Majority of the students hail from South 24 Parganas and South Kolkata and belong families of farmers, land laborers and have poor financial background. The Women Cell and Equal Opportunity & Gender Equity Cell at Sammilani Mahavidyalaya believe providing the students with only higher education is not enough to eradicate or ease age-old issues related gender inequality; their higher education should be supplemented with appropriate initiatives on women empowerment. To equip them potentially to fight the menace the Cells believe that understanding of the gender reality is the first and foremost pre-requisite.

Context

Under-age marriage, female child malnutrition, girl trafficking, dowry, domestic violence targeting women, etc. are prevalent in many regions. Social gender equality cannot be achieved and sustained as long as even a small fraction of society remains marginalized and thus kept behind. Youths have the power which has undeniable influence in constructing and deconstructing existing social values which will ultimately change the way of social living across gender including all - male, female, transgender, gender neutral, non-binary, pangender, genderqueer, two-spirit, third gender, and all, none or a combination of these.

Therefore, the Women Cell and Equal Opportunity & Gender Equity Cell at Sammilani Mahavidyalaya initiated a social survey, called gender audit, among our own students regarding their views on some selected personal, family and social issues. The survey tried to capture the gendered familial educational profile, opinions on social structure and earning status of each respondent as their background as well.

The main objective of gender audit is women empowerment through dissemination of knowledge and generation of awareness by providing them with knowledge on prevailing perception on various gender related issues as listed below:

- Brief structure related to existing social norms
- Purpose of pursuing education
- Existence of gender inequality in family, in the institution and in their society, if any
- The causes behind sexual harassment, if any
- The position of all members irrespective of all genders in their family about equal opportunity in education, in equal access of food & nutrition, medical treatment, equal participation in decision making, equal freedom in choosing dresses



- Whether the college campus is safe for all specially for women and transgender
- Opinion on women rights
- Facilities like self-defense training programs, sports facility, grievance redressal cell, Women's cell, Internal Complaints Committee

Methodology

The Women Cell and Equal Opportunity & Gender Equity Cell conducted the gender audit through Google Form in order to collate the respondents' perception on the existing belief structure of the respondents on different social norms like gender role in work, both inside and outside household, reservation facilities in public transportation, son preference in the family, societal norms, etc. Since the status of women at home and in the society at large depends on the mindset of all the stakeholders, in addition to other prevailing customs and practices, it has collected data from the girl and boy students as well and on various issues ranging from their personal opinion, family practice to societal norms.

A set of questionnaires (Annexure 1) have been asked to the present through Google form. Both MCQ type and short answer type questionnaires have been floated. Data and diagrams were collected as produced on the Google Analysis Form.

Analysis of the Survey (Session 2022-2023):

1. Family Profile of the Respondents

a. Sex Composition:




Figure 1: Over all Sex Composition of Student's Family (Session 2022-2023)

The analysis shows that the number of males in the families of all 151 respondents for the session 2022–2023 is 293 (49.7%) while total number of females is 296 (50.3%) (Figure 1). Over all sex ratio is approximately 1010 female per 1000 male.

b. Educational Attainment of the respondents' family:

The analysis shows that the illiteracy level of the respondents' fathers (3.81%) is less compared to mother (5.30%). The percentage of educational attainment of respondents' mothers up to Secondary level is higher than that of fathers. At UG



level the reduction in attainment percentage is significant in case of respondents' mothers (16.56%) than that of fathers (29.14%). However, at PG level the educational attainment of father is 2.65% (Table – 1).

It can therefore be concluded that the students of this college come from a family background where 29.14% fathers and 16.56% of mothers are educated at undergraduate level and 2.65% of fathers attend post graduate level of education. But 3.31% of father 5.30% mother are still illiterate. Interestingly, it is evident from the Table 1 that the percentage of sisters attaining UG and PG level is significantly higher than that of brothers of the students. This may be due to the number of elder sisters are more than the elder brothers. However, at Ph.D. level the educational attainment of sister (1.35%) is observed.




Figure 2: Earning Status of the family of the respondents (Session 2022-2023)

- c. Earning Status of the Family:** It is evident from Figure 2 that male earning members of the family of the respondents' is 77% and women earning members is 23%.

d. Student's Opinion about his/her family's Gender Power Structure in Basic Access and Decision-Making:




Figure 3: Student's Opinion about his/her family's Gender Power Structure in Basic Access and Decision-Making (Session 2022-2023)

Figure 3 analyses the gender power structure in accessing a few basic opportunities and participation of all genders in family decision making.

In accessing the equal opportunities in education, food and nutrition, medical treatment, equal freedom in choosing dress, it is observed that highest level of gender equality is attained in equal food and nutrition (93% of respondents) followed by medical treatment and freedom in choosing dress (88% both), education (85%). 84% of the students responded for equal participation in decision making for family matters.

2. Inspiration and purpose of pursuing college education by the respondents:

39% of the students responded that the main inspiration behind their college education comes from father and 25% of the students responded that the inspiration comes from mother and followed by elder brothers and sisters. Therefore, it is concluded that the main inspiration and support behind college education comes from the family.






Figure 4: Inspiration behind college education of the students (Session 2022-2023)

Purpose of College education:




Figure 5: Purpose of college education (Session 2022-2023)

Majority (46%) of the students consider acquiring knowledge is the most important purpose behind college education, while 43% of the students consider employment and self grooming is the main purpose of their college education. Whereas, 8% of the students think the financial empowerment is the purpose behind their college education. However, very few students respond for good marriage and none has responded for social status, and to avail kanyashree, to get stipend as their main purpose of their college education (Figure 5).

Rape, Terrorism, Violence against woman, Unemployment, Dowry, Feticide, Communalism, Human trafficking and Corruption are most common current problems in today's society. 


Figure 6a: Students' opinion on Social Problems (Session 2022-2023)




Figure 6b: Incidents occurred in the students' family (Session 2022-2023)







4. Belief Structure of Students’ on Social Norms




Figure 7: Belief structure of students on social norms (Session 2022-2023)

The survey result shows that 51% of the young respondents disagree with Violence on men dominate over on that of women. As far as the effectiveness of the kanyashree scheme in promoting college education to woman to boost up their empowerment 48% of the students doubt the effectiveness of the scheme. Regarding the seat reservation for women in public transport nearly 68% of the respondents agreed for the preference. The cause behind the preference lies in practical harassment experienced by the women while travelling in public transport. The role of male and female inside and outside of the family show a very positive direction for the society. 74% of the students disagree with the statement "Female inside household and men in outside workplace". The



survey result shows that all most 86% agreed with the statement “Women should be in decision / policy making role wherever possible” (Figure 7).

5. Reason behind Violence/ Sexual Harassment against women and Transgender:




Figure 8 Reason behind violence/sexual harassment against women and transgender:

According to analysis it is observed that 47% of the respondents consider the most important cause behind the Violence/ Sexual Harassment against women and Transgender is Lack of awareness on the existing law. It is followed by Male Lust (11%), Internet based Social media effect (9%), Unemployment problem (7%), Police inaction and Family indifference (5% both), Incautiousness and effect of TV and serials (4% both) improper dress (3%) (Figure 8).

6. Opinion of students about the existence gender sensitivity in the institution:




Figure 9: Opinion of students about the existence of gender sensitivity in the institution

64% of the students believe that there is no gender sensitivity exists in the institution (Figure 9).

7. Awareness of the existing facilities of the institution:




Figure 10: Awareness of the existing facilities of the institution

Most of the students (83%) aware of the existence of the sports facilities provided by the institution. 73% of the students aware that the institution conducted self defense program. 70% students aware about the Grievance redressal cell. However, more 63% the students are aware about the existence of the internal complaints cell to prevent sexual harassment in the institution. 76% of the students are aware that the institution has not yet installed sanitary pad vending machine (Figure 10).

8. Students' Opinion about the safety of women and transgender, equal opportunities for all gender in the institution and opinion about equal rights of all gender in the country:




Figure 11: Students' opinion about the safety of women and transgender, equal opportunities for all gender in the institution and opinion about equal rights of all gender in the country

75% of the students agreed that equal opportunities are extended to all genders, 74% of the students agreed that the college campus is safe for women and transgender. Whereas, 48% of the students believe that all genders has equal rights in our country (Figure 11).

Summary

The online survey for gender audit was conducted jointly by the Women Cell and Equal Opportunity & Gender Equity Cell. Some interesting information have been revealed by the student respondents at Sammilani Mahavidyalaya most of whom come from southern parts of South 24 Parganas and Kolkata.

The survey reveals that the education level is improving with the advancement of the generation though the overall higher education level of mothers and elder sisters is higher compared to other fathers. However, fathers are the prime bread-winner, encourages son/daughter in education.



More than two-third respondents believe equality is prevalent in food and nutrition, medical treatment, education, and decision making. The extent of liberty in choosing a dress to wear has been improved from 84% last year to 88% this year.

About 43% respondents' main objective of education is to get settled in life through employment and wellbeing and 46% said their objective is to acquire knowledge. However, about three-fourth of them are concerned with unemployment and corruption.

In total about one-fourth respondents are concerned about rape, human trafficking, violence and dowry compared to one-third of last years' respondents. Interestingly, 8% of them offering dowry whereas only 3% is receiving the same.

Seat reservation in public transport is a must for safety of the girls – about 68% demand the same to avoid bullying and sexual harassment during public transport. About 47% believe that lack of awareness on existing laws to prevent sexual harassment is the main reason for the menace in the society.

A sign of women empowerment is visible from the survey analysis – 74% of the respondents disagree with the slogan 'female inside, male outside'. And 86% respondent believe women should be in decision and policy making.

More than 70% respondents acknowledge the role of the institution in providing sports facilities, self-defence courses for girls, Internal Complaints Committee, Anti-ragging Cell and Grievance Cell. However, they feel a sanitary pad vending machine will ease some issues related to privacy and hygiene.

Recommendation of the audit team:


- 1) To organize more sensitization programme like seminars, workshops, etc. on women empowerment

CERTIFICATE COURSE ON SELF-DEFENCE (FOR GIRLS' ONLY)

Self defence can be termed as an act by any individual or groups involving reasonable force to defend one's self.

OBJECTIVES:

ANTI RAGGING CELL

OBJECTIVES: It is an essential body that arrange necessary events and take steps in way to prevent ragging and making the Institution a ragging free campus. This anti ragging cell works on regular basis to create awareness among students to prevent such incidents. A zero-tolerance stance of the administration is essential to create a safe academic ecosystem to build a confident student mind for academic excellence and value recognition. The anti- ragging cell and anti -ragging squad work hand in hand through surprise visits, student's enquiry and other sudden drives that play affective role in making students abstain from ragging. The institution also collects affidavits from all the students who ever take admission in the institution so that everybody shall be aware of and remain abstained from such incidents.

Plan of action:

1. **Organizing seminars, work- shops and posting of signages:** The anti- ragging cell perform regular and continuous awareness among all the students through different activities for cognitive and value reconstruction. The objective of the cell is to prevent ragging through all the possible ways. However if any such unfortunate cases happen the anti- ragging cell take a zero tolerance stance to combat the situation.
2. **Collection of complains followed by its assessment:** The victim of any ragging can post his/her complaint over phone calls, e mails, physical letters or he/ she can meet physically to the competent authority to address the same. On receiving the complaint the members of the anti ragging cell arrange a meeting with the internal members and with to discuss and analyze the issue.
3. **Arrangement of hearings:** The anti ragging cell thereafter arrange hearings for people under three categories namely the victim, alleged and any alibi/ trace passer separately. During this meet the cell receives f description of events, opinions and information related to the event from them. The cell also collects other relevant information to understand the psychological condition of the victims and alleged. The entire process is done secretly. All the information is being collected in written for future references.
4. **Analysis of event followed by preparation of questionnaires:** The members of the cell there after discuss the information collected during hearing and try to reconstruct the event. The purpose is to understand the truth and to figure out the anomaly and mis information if provided during hearing. On the basis of the initial information and its subsequent analysis the anti-ragging cell prepare separate questionnaires to verify and validate their answers or provided information. The questionnaires are presented before the victims, alleged and alibi/trace passers and their responses are recorded.
5. **Verification and validation of responses:** On submission of the responses against all the questionnaire, the anti-ragging cell cross check all the answer to **figure out any false statement, wrong information and false allegation provided intentionally, during the entire course of enquiries either by the victim or by the alleged or even by the alibi.**
6. **Preparation of report and proposal of action:** On the basis of the submitted information, answers to the questionnaires, other relevant information and subsequent analyses the anti-ragging cell prepare a final report and propose a plan of action. The cell then submits the final report and plan of action to the highest authority.
7. **Action taken:** On the basis of the submitted report and proposal of action of anti-ragging cell the highest authority after through psychological counselling take necessary actions for both the victim and the accused.

OBJECTIVE: it plays a vital role in handling any kind of queries officially and legally. It provides information to the applicant under the existing RTI Act 2005 as and when required.

The objective of RTI act 2005 is to empower citizen , promote openness and accountability in government operation combat corruption and to make an democracy for the people in true sense. A citizen can seek information from Govt offices department, ministers from Govt offices, departments, ministers and all the organizations run by the Govt. of India on any other organization substantially aided by the Govt of India or any other State Govt.,

Plan of action:

1. Any one can seek information in writing on a blank paper addressed to the SPIO of the college.
2. Submission of the evidence of Payment of application fee along with the application is very much needed
3. send the application to SPIO.
4. If there is no reply from SPIO within 35 days an application should be sent to Appellate authority of the college.

THE FIRST TIER

5. The first tier RTI is filing in college is SPIO (state public information officer under section of the RTI Act. He/ she is required to provide information in an RTI applicant as expeditiously as per section 7as possible, and in any casewithin 30 days of receipt of a request 7.

SECOND TIER

The second tier is designated as the first appellated authority (FAA). A RTI applicant whodoes not get the required information with in the specific time or is aggrieved by the decision of CPIO may, within 30 days, address his first appeal to an officersenior in rank to each public authority.

THIRD TIER

The third tier is the central information commission. An information seeker can file a second appealto him/ her against the order of FAAif he is not satisfied or does not receivean order from FAA with in the specified time as per section 19(3) of RTI Act.



Some of these domains are Classroom: teaching learning, water: drinking and other usages; Paper work: office; Hygiene / cleaning: Toilets, rooms and college premises; Food: canteen; Books, magazines, computer: library services etc. Sammilani Mahavidyalaya grievance redressal cell continuously works on the grievances to meet with the expectation of the students and other stake holders. It receives and preserves all the complaints of students and other stake holder and perform needful action to redress the grievances through coordination with other relevant sub committees and higher authority as and when required.

PLAN OF ACTION:

- Regular monitoring and maintenance:** Different subcommittees and Grievance Redress cell carry out regular monitoring and supervise maintenance services to meet with the compliances of the Institutional benchmark. It covers all the services and facilities that an Institution could offer to. From class room teaching to library facility, from drinking water to canteen food products, from hygienic toilet to a plastic free college campus and so on.
- Complains collected by Grievance Redressal cell:** The Institution cater over more or less 2000 stake holders on regular basis through diversified services. As the beneficiaries are from different socio-economic sections the chances of short comings of some of the services are always there. The Grievance Redress cell thus arranged a grievance drop box where one can submit/ post his/her complaint as and when required. The members of the Grievance Redress cell Collect all the grievances on regular interval.
- Analysis of Grievances:** Grievance Redress cell categorize and analyze the complaints and meet with the aggrieved stake holder/ holders to get additional information and suggestions from them.
- Understanding of Grievance specific needs and demands:** The members of the grievance redressal cell inspect every complaint physically and prepare a priority list and set a time schedule for the actions to be taken. Case specific discussion with respective subcommittees and meeting with the internal members of the cell are being carried out to finalize the plan of action and to issue additional demand if any.
- Final proposal:** The Grievance Redress cell submits its final proposal along with the demand, priority list and time schedule of action to the higher authority. It also furnishes additional information collected from stake holders, relevant subcommittee or even from their self-experience during the process, if found useful during redressing grievances and also for future references.
- Action and follow up to redress grievances:** The proposal, demands and additional requirements (if any) once approved by the higher authority are send back to the Grievance redressal cell for necessary action to redress the issues. The members of the cell finally take necessary steps to redress the grievances under supervision of relevant sub committees and student representatives. Once the action is taken Grievance Redress cell members and coordinator take a follow up and feedback to ensure smooth functioning of the entire process, progress and its efficacy. The cell Records the entire episode from origin of grievances till its redressal and follow up through its meeting and adopted resolutions.

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





Self defence can be termed as an act by any individual or groups involving reasonable force to defend one's self.


Objectives:



- To enable girl students combat different types of violent situations arising against them.

Overview:

Enhancement of self confidence among girls is a bare necessity to enable them to be strong both physically and mentally to tackle any untoward situation they come across in their day to day life. In some cases to defend and raise an alarm.


They were made aware on escaping techniques against different hold and chokes.


This training enhanced the physical strength of the girls and a very positive trend in terms of interest was witnessed in college when this programme was being imparted.

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



